Accomplishments

Alexander & Baldwin has incorporated numerous sustainability efforts to conserve Hawaii's precious resources and uphold our responsibility to the community and future generations.

Below we list some of the impacts of our efforts:

- Directly produced **40,000+** megawatt hours of renewable energy in 2018, which is more than half the amount of energy used by our entire commercial real estate operations.
- Directly and through A&B-related entities produced **23%** of Kauai's energy from renewable sources in 2018, accelerating the island's 70% renewable energy goal by 2030.
- Piloted a comprehensive energy and GHG reduction program at four commercial properties that will eliminate usage of **22,500 barrels** of oil over 10 years.
- Over **135,000 tons** of asphalt recycled annually by Grace Pacific.
- Repurposed a former sugar plantation well for irrigation use at Maui Business Park II, **saving 200,000 gallons** of potable water per day.

- Provided **over 10,000 acres** for conservation purposes, spanning three preserves managed by The Nature Conservancy on Maui and Kauai.
- Voluntarily designated over **3,700 acres** on Kauai as Important Agricultural Lands to assure the long-term availability of agriculturally suitable lands.
- **Founding member** of East Maui Watershed Partnership, which protects a 100,000-acre watershed on Maui and ensures clean water for the island's future generations.
- **Over \$7 million** in charitable donations over the last seven years to support health and human services, education, community/civic, culture and the arts, and environmental/land stewardship causes.
- **Reduced paper consumption** by thousands of reams of paper annually with electronic invoicing to 90% of tenants.
